Parent Appointments for P1-7

We will be using Parent Booking as a system to do our online appointments at the start of February. This evening, the main contact for your child should have received an email from the Parent Booking system.

It is the first time we have used this system so fingers crossed it all goes smoothly. If you would like an appointment, please log into the system to book a slot. The booking process will be open from now, until the evening of the 26th January. The appointments are available on Tues 1st Feb 3:30-6:30.

If you wish to change the appointment so that it goes to the parent who is not the main contact, you will need to let me know.

For children who have separated parents, I hope that you can communicate between each other regarding the appointment for the main contact to attend. I understand that there are sometimes circumstances when this is not possible. This may be due to court cases or other serious matters. In such cases, if requested, we can offer a separate appointment. Please get in touch if this is required.

If your child receives regular meetings that discuss progress and achievement, please do not book an appointment as your separate meetings will be more in depth for your child.
