The time has come for a new national discussion on education, one which will give everyone the chance to have their voice heard. We're inviting everyone who has an interest in the future of our education system: children and young people, parents and carers, practitioners, and those in the wider Scottish community to pause, to reflect and to contribute to a future vision for Scottish education.

In the survey you will find 10 open questions about the future of education in Scotland. You are welcome to reply to some or all of them.

What is important is that you have the chance to have your say and can reflect deeply on the topics that matter the most to you.

All responses will be independently analysed and used to set a vision for Scotland's future education.' (Scottish Government)

Christmas Jumpers

Lyth Arts Centre Show for ELC and P1-4 – Tuesday 13th December

On Tuesday 13th December the ELC and P1-4 will be attending a show in Lyth Arts Centre. They will be out of school from approximately 12:30-2:30. They will be travelling by bus with staff.

Lyth Arts will be refunding 80% of the bus costs and tickets will be paid from the school budget.

Christmas Concert - Tuesday 20^h December at 6:30pm in the Canisbay Community Hall

- Doors open for parents, children and the audience from 6:10pm.
- Only helpers or Parent Council setting up for raffle will be allowed in before this time.
- No tickets are needed for the concert but there will be a donations box at the door.
- The Parent Council will also be selling raffle tickets at the entrance
- Most children will have their outfits at the hall to get changed there (if this is needed)
- Staff will get in touch with any specific requirements for their class
- Families should ensure that children are registered with the teacher or Early Years Practitioner. As soon as that is done you are free to get your seats. The P1-4 and ELC children will register in the Youth Club room, which is through the back of the small hall.
- Once registered, children need to stay with their class.
- Children need to wear flat shoes which will not make a noise on the stage for the show. Gym shoes from school will be taken up to the hall for that purpose.
- After the P1-4 and ELC classes have performed they will remain at the seating on the front row with members of staff, to watch the remainder of the concert.
- At the end of the concert, children will return to the place where they registered. They can then be collected from this area. It is important that the class teacher or Early Years Practitioners are told, so that your child can be ticked off the register.
- It is strongly recommended that no under 3s attend the concert however if you have no other option, please just be aware that if your child cries or is being very noisy it would really help us if they were taken away from the audience. The sound is not always great in the hall and any other sounds can mean that the play is not heard at all which I am sure you would agree would be a great shame for the children performing. Audience members have requested this in the past.
- All school and ELC children are expected to perform at the evening Christmas Concert so we ask you to confirm their attendance on this Google Form https://forms.gle/ZsuiZxbrrtBbtEtp8
